Following the receipt of an Academy Order from the Department of Education, we would like to continue the consultation process on the decision to convert to an academy with the Hart Schools Trust. In addition to the Parent Forums we held back in November, we have planned another opportunity to speak with both school and trust leaders at the up-coming Parents Evening.
