In the build up to SATs, the children will experience a range of genres, where they will be reading, analysing and then writing examples of the following types of texts: Non

Chronological reports

Diary Extracts

Persuasive writing- discussion texts and arguments

Narrative

Grammar will continue to be a large part of our learning, revising a lot of the content that we have been taught in Key Stage 2 as well as introducing new learning with informal and formal construction of sentences in speech and writing.

Science

Evolution and inheritance

In this topic the children will be taught how living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. We will look at how living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents. Finally the children will look at how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

PSHE

They will be learning about how to become a good learner and the different skills that are involved in this. In addition to this we will learn a bit about aspiration and how to plan for the future with their ambitions. We will also attend Crucial Crew which will provide the children with opportunities to take part in scenarios related to being a good citizen.

Computing

Information Models

We will spend some time looking at spreadsheets with a focus on structure of labelled sheets and how columns and rows enable us to locate and change specific cells or ranges.

Autumn term

Topic WATER WATER EVERYWHERE! (Coastlines)

In this Topic we will be finding out about Physical geography associated with Coastlines. The children will be learning how coastlines are formed (erosion and deposition) and how human influences can affect them.

French

We will revise numbers, colours and then look at facial and body features and to be able to describe themselves using simple French language and vocabulary.

Religious Education

We will be learning about Christian and Buddhist beliefs and practices. Then we will look at Christmas.

Maths

We will start the term revising place value of number and then revise the methods for Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, making sure that we know all of the efficient methods. We will then start looking at Fractions and learn mental arithmetic methods for adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions. A lot of the work will also get the children to become fluent in their use of number as well as developing reasoning and problem solving skills.

Physical Education

We will work through a variety of Invasion Games including Tag Rugby and then we will complete some Outdoor and Adventurous activities as well as completing some at Kingswood.
