RE: Mini Police Scheme

We are very lucky to have secured a project with Stevenage Police Force. Children in Year Five will be participating in a six week, 'Mini Police Scheme,' after the half-term holiday. The first session will commence on Wednesday 27th February. Sessions will run consecutively for a six week period and will be organised and delivered by our local PSCO, Caitilin Sirkett.

Over the course of the half-term, many different visitors will accompany PCSO Sirkett on her visits, including PCs, undercover officers and armed police. They will discuss their roles in the different sectors of the force in which they work.

As children progress with the project they will learn about the negative impact of social media, the damaging effects of bullying, as well as selecting some of their own topics. At the end of the programme the children will visit the police station for a graduation ceremony, where they will officially gain the title of Mini Police!

We have specifically requested this work due to some on-going issues around bullying, friendship issues and the damaging effects of social media incidents.

We look forward to working with PCSO Sirkett as the scheme progresses.
