Graduating from Birmingham Conservatoire in 2008 with a First Class BMus (Hons) degree, Bridget is a freelance singer based in Hertfordshire and works across the UK and Europe. In demand as a solo and choral singer Bridget has sung with Ex Cathedra, Birmingham Bach Choir, The Holst Singers, Armonico Consort, Ensemble Plus Ultra, Convivium Singers and the Philharmonia Chorus Professional Singers' Scheme. With her one to one teaching she has also worked as a vocal tutor with Peterborough Cathedral in association with the Chorister Outreach Programme 'Sing Up'. Recent recordings include Mahler's Second Symphony with the Philharmonia Orchestra and Chorus as part of the Professional singers' scheme, Faure Requiem with Convivium Singers and Shared Earth (Music by Alec Roth) with Ex Cathedra. As well as a teacher for Hertfordshire Music Service Bridget teaches singing for The National Children's Choir of Great Britain and has previously work with Ex Cathedra's education scheme.
