

MISSED LESSONS AND CREDITS

When the teacher is available at the scheduled lesson time but the student is unable to attend, the lesson is forfeited and no refund can be made. If the teacher is absent, every effort will be made to make up the lesson at a future date but, if this cannot be done, a credit will be issued for the missed lesson. Such credits are calculated at the end of the academic year and we ask you not to deduct 'presumed' credits as there are opportunities to make up missed lessons during the longer terms. Registers are kept for invoicing and record keeping and used as the source of information for any queries about accounts.

TERMINATING LESSONS

Should you wish to discontinue lessons or membership of a group activity, a full half term's written notice to the Head of Centre is required, with lessons ending at the end of a full term. Deadline dates are published on the website and locally in the centre. In the absence of written notice, a further term's fees will be payable.
