

## English

The children will be looking at a range of different texts and immersing themselves into a wide range of learning opportunities. The texts we shall be studying are 'The Princess and the Warrior', 'Lucia the Warrior' and 'The Dead Family'.

The children will aim to write their own versions of the story, linking familiar events together and using their own ideas. They will also explore other genres such as Explanation texts and Discussion texts.

## Science

Year 4 will be studying circuits and components. They will be constructing simple circuits with appropriate equipment. They will also recognise a range of appliances that need electricity to work, and be able to identify conductors and insulators of electricity.

The children may be able to identify whether a circuit will work or not by testing components and checking whether they are faulty.

## PSHE

The children will be learning about living in the wider world. They will discover how to keep themselves healthy in the wider world before discussing current issues and how these issues may affect them in the future.

The children will also be studying SRE this term. They will learn about how their bodies are changing during puberty as well as recapping the male and female body parts.

## Computing

Children will continue to show various ways to bring images to life. So far they have used flipbooks, word documents and animation software to enhance visual images and make them move. They will then create sound effects to go with these images in a short story scene. The children will also resume learning about E-Safety and use of email from earlier in the year.

## Maths

The children will be focusing on reading graphs and tables in the first few weeks, leading on to asking and answering questions about the data given. The emphasis will then switch to fractions including improper fractions. They should then be able to add and subtract fractions confidently.

There will be a continued focus on multiplication facts, continuing to learn and practice multiplication facts weekly. The children will be able to calculate mentally with increased fluency throughout the term.



# Year 4

# Summer Term

## Religious Education

Year 4 will be learning about a range of areas of religion to expand their knowledge already gained.

## Topic

### Mexico

The children will be exploring many different aspects of Mexican culture this term. After gathering a variety of ideas from the children themselves, the children will begin acquiring knowledge about the geography of Mexico as well as the historic festivals that take place in Mexico.

The children will study maps, atlases and globes to accurately plot Mexico in the world and begin to understand climate differences between Mexico and the UK.



## Physical Education

Children will be studying Golf this term, understanding how to take a shot and improve on previous performances by enhancing technique used. There will be putting and pitching exercises to help this.

The children will then move onto Athletics activities in preparation for the upcoming Sports Day events.
