

## English

The children will be exploring and retelling traditional tales (involving pirates) alongside creating character profiles of pirates and designing their own story settings (our own island).

We will be learning, reciting and adding actions to pirate poetry and songs focussing on identifying the rhyming words.

The children will create a pirate handbook containing facts on pirates and their lives.

This half term we will be beginning our new topic called 'Looking at animals'. The children in year 1 will be identifying, naming and comparing a variety of different animals including birds and fish. We will be studying their body structures and the way that they move.
