Science

Where does the food go?

Children will be describing the simple functions and roles of the parts of the digestive system. They will look at different types of teeth and what they are used for.

Geography

We will be using atlases to locate Egypt and the River Nile. We will be looking at a range of geographical features of this region, relating this to where populations settled, and undertaking various map work.

Maths

- Understanding equivalent fractions and comparing fractions. Adding and subtracting fractions.
- Decimals - understanding tenths, hundredths and thousands. Comparing and rounding decimals.
- Telling the time at 5 minutes intervals. Converting between hours and minutes. Adding & subtracting units of time and calculating time durations.
- Calculating the area & perimeter of shape.
- Identifying right angles. Measuring and drawing angles up to 180°.
- Continuing to learn and recall all multiplication facts up to 12 x 12.

Music (Charanga)

Stop!

A rap/song about bullying through which the children will learn about the interrelated dimensions of music.

Lean on me

Children will explore pulse, rhythm and pitch through singing and playing instruments.

We will be exploring the achievements of the Egyptians, looking at when and where this civilization first appeared and looking in depth at their language, religion, important Kings & Queens and their various rituals and way of life.
