Polar bears are the largest living land carnivore, feeding mainly on seals and walruses. They have strong, powerful jaws filled with sharp teeth. This allows them to tear the flesh off their prey.

Mcle polar bears can grow up to 10 feet and weigh up to 450kg. Females can reach 7 feet and weigh between 150kg and 250kg. In the wild, polar bears can live up to 25 years of age.

### Did you know?

Despite the fact that they live in the Arctic, polar bears are still under threat. Humans are the only predator of polar bears and their numbers are under threat from hunting. Humans kill polar bears primarily for food and their fur.

Relative clauses are clauses starting with the relative pronouns who, that, which, whose, where, when. They are most often used to define or identify the noun that precedes them.

### Facts and Figures

These are used to make the description precise or factual.

### Expanded noun phrases

An expanded noun phrase is a phrase made up of a noun and at least one adjective. If one or more adjectives are listed to describe the noun, a comma should be added to separate the sentence.
