

English

- We will produce a suspense story based on 'Wolves in the Wall'. The children will be using different techniques to create tension and suspense.
- We will also be writing a holiday brochure about a European country. We will be looking at persuasive features to entice people to visit.
- We will also be exploring some poetry by Roger McGough. We will be looking at a range of different poems where we will be acting, drawing and writing our own.

Maths

- Learn about pounds and pence. We shall be converting pence to pounds and comparing different amounts.
- We will also be learning how to add and subtract money mentally.
- We will be adding and subtracting money using regrouping.
- We will be learning number of seconds in a minute and the number of days in each month, year and leap year.
- We will estimate and read time with increasing accuracy and compare times.
- We will tell and write the time from an analogue clock in 12 and 24 hour clocks.
- We will be measuring, comparing, adding and subtracting volume and capacity.
- We will be measuring, comparing, adding and subtracting lengths.

Science

During our topic on plants we will be looking at different plants and their parts. We will be focusing on different parts of the plant and why they are useful. We shall be exploring what would happen if plants didn't have leaves or roots and how this would affect growth. We will also look at pollination and seed dispersal and how important it is for plant cycles. We will be looking at the importance of bees and how we can look after them for our environment.

Computing

Throughout all our work, we will use technology safely and responsibly.

For this half term, we will be looking at branching databases and graphing. The children will be sorting objects using yes/no and using 2Question to create their own databases. In Graphing, the children will be entering data into a graph and answer questions.

D&T and Art

In D&T, we will be producing a felt textile cushion. We will be focusing on our designing and sewing skills.

In Art, we will be looking at our crafting skills. We will be learning how to tie dye and weave.
