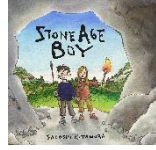


English

- Using prepositions and adverbials to help writing to flow

Computing

We will learn:

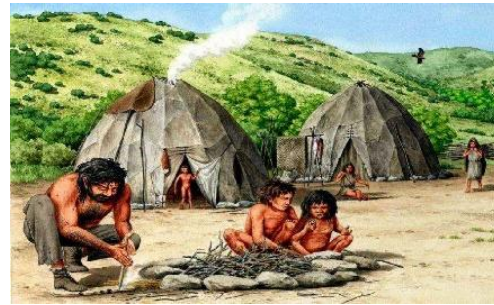
- How prehistoric man-made art

Year 3 Autumn Term Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age

Science

Rocks, soil and fossils



For this half term and next, we will be exploring rocks and soils. Our learning will tell us how to classify types of rock, how fossils are formed, the links between rocks and soils as well as how weathering impacts rocks.

History - Stone Age to Iron Age

We will carry out a number of historic investigations including:

- How long ago did prehistoric man live?
- What does Skara Brae teach us about life in the Stone Age?
- What was the impact of bronze in prehistoric Britain?
What changed between the Stone Age and Iron Age?

Religious Education

We will learn:

- What is a soul
- What is spirituality

We will be engaging in outdoor adventurous activity and problem solving. We will be working together as a team to undertake adventurous challenges that will encourage us to develop our growth mindset.
