

## English

To begin our topic, we will look at a non-fiction text about 'Our body' and writing our own book based around our senses.

We will be reading 'The Smartest Giant in Town' and recreate our own version using patterned language.

## PSHE

Alongside our topic, our PSHE lessons will be looking at what it takes to lead a healthy lifestyle. This includes personal hygiene, learning how germs are spread and the safe use of medicines.

We will also be discussing how feelings, and how to manage them appropriately.

## Music

This term our focus is on Latin Music.

This term we are finishing off our addition and subtraction to 20 topic. Moving on to look at shape, we will be naming 2D and 3D shapes and describing their properties

## Science

Our focus is the Human body.

We will identify and name the main parts of our body.

We will be looking at the concept of five senses that help us to find out about the world around us and we will be linking those senses to particular parts of our body.

## Phonics

## Art
