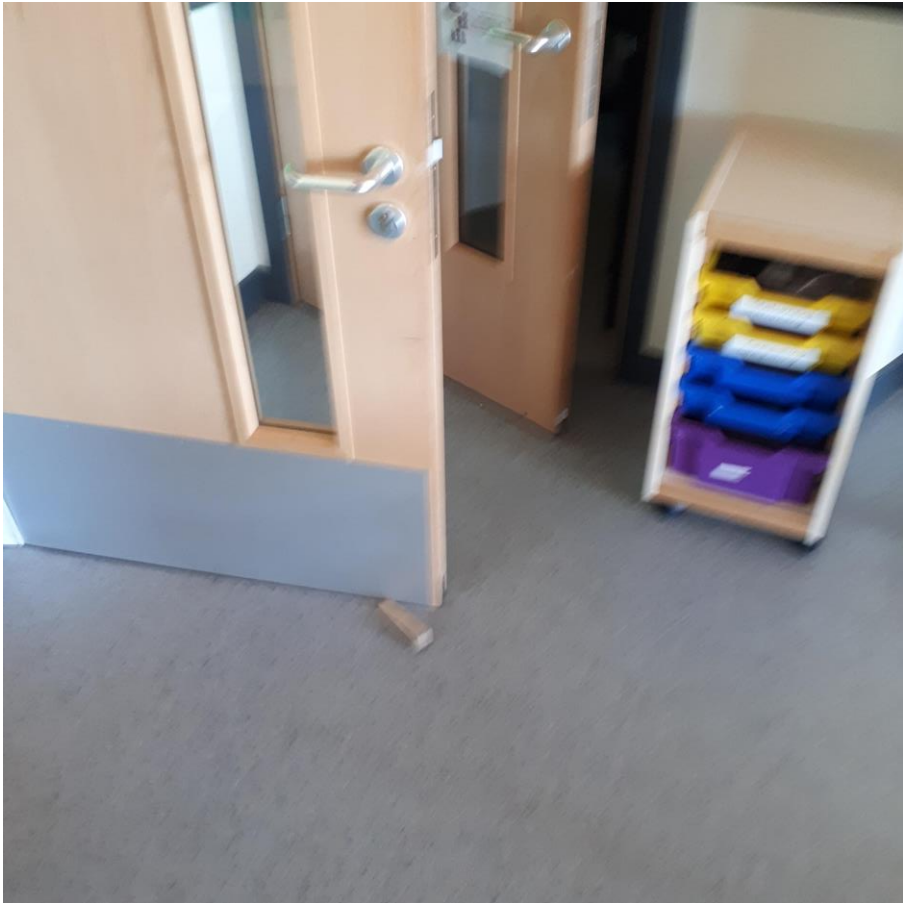

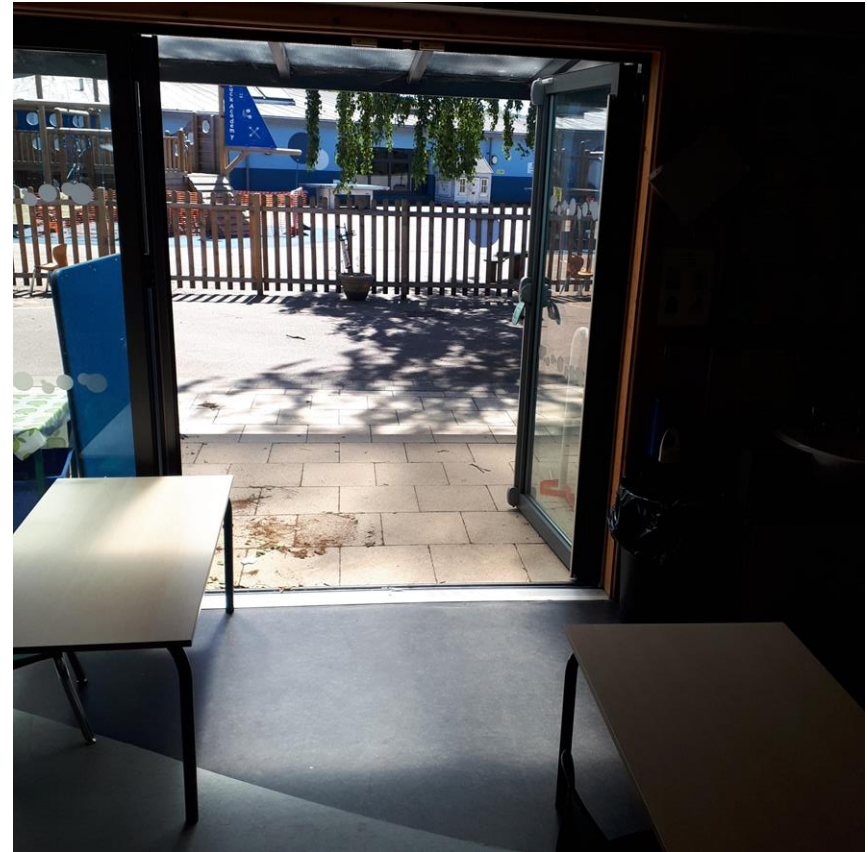

unnecessary touching

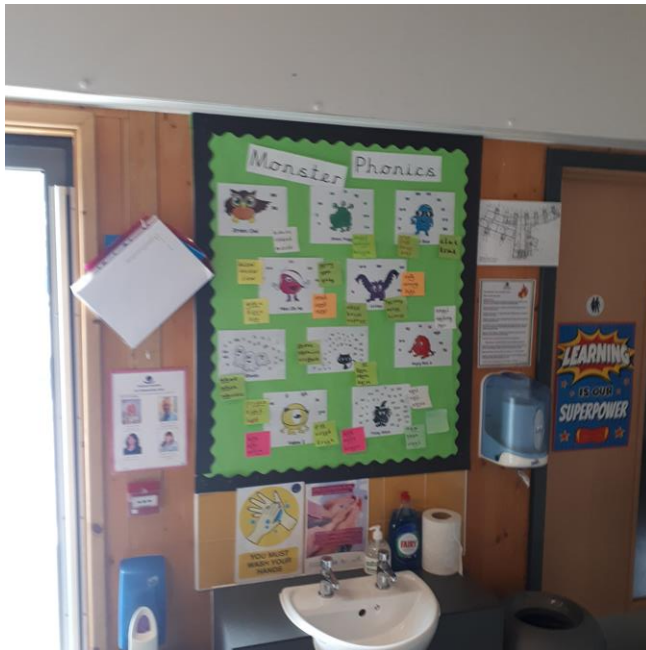


Windows and bi-folding doors
